## Instructions for filling out the Official Candidate Petitions for Jay's Candidacy

By now you have downloaded the .pdf document onto your computer. If you are viewing this document in your browser, then push the back button and left click the link and select save as... to download it.

You will need to print the first two pages of this document, and if you can please print it double sided. Although the government told me they want the copies to be double sided, legally we can still turn them in as two one-sided documents, but only if they are stapled together.

So print the first two pages, double-sided if you can, or you can staple the two pages afterwards. If you are not able to staple them for whatever reason, then do not send them into a county office directly (will talk more about where to send it later), please send it directly to me (Jay), my address is bellow.

You will need to fill out both sides of the petition, and it will need to be perfectly correct or your signature will not be counted, so I am going to talk you through it step by step. It's pretty simple though, just make sure to complete all of these steps.

On the first page you can skip the three boxes on the top, those are for election officials. The first blank space has been pre-filled in by an election official with my name as the candidate. The next blank space has been filled in with the office I am running for.

The next blank space, after "I am a resident of \_\_\_\_\_" must to be filled in with the county the people signing the petition live in. If you are signing the petition it would be your county.

Next you can print and sign your name, and write the address where you are REGESTERD to vote. You must be registered to vote in the county that you just filled in above. Anyone who lives in a separate county must sign a different copy that has their county filled in instead.

That's it for the first page... not too bad. Now for the back-side.

As you can see, up to 10 people, from the same county, can sign this petition. You must print or copy more petitions to collect more signatures.

Since you have printed this petition, you have become the "Circulator" of the petition and therefore you must sign the Affidavit of Circulator on the back of the petition. If you don't want to go to the trouble to fill this out, you can sill send it back to me, but your signature might not count, and have a lesser chance if there is more than one signature on the petition (definitely do not send it directly to your county government without the back filled out).

The first blank after "I, \_\_\_\_" is simply filled in with your name.

The next blank after "I secured signatures in the county of \_\_\_\_" is filled in with the county of where the people live who signed the petition. This must be the same as the county on the front.

The next blank after "in-lieu of filing fee of \_\_\_\_" is filled in with my name. I write it as: Jay (Blas Jacob Cabrera). If your wondering why it says "in-lieu of filing fee" when you may have thought these were nomination signatures, then look at the bottom of the first page. In really small writing it explains that these signatures can be applied towards nomination.

The next blank after "candidate for the office of \_\_\_\_" is filled in with the same office that is preprinted on the front of the petition.

The next blanks after "signatures were obtained between \_\_\_\_\_, 20 \_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_, 20 \_\_\_" is filled in with the month and day of when the first signer signed the petition and the last signer. If only one person signed it, or everyone signed it on the same day, then these could be the same date. What is important is that the date is after April  $23^{rd}$ , 2010 and before July  $22^{nd}$  2010.

The next blank after "My residence address is \_\_\_\_\_" is filled in with the address you are registered to vote at.

The next two blanks after "true and correct \_\_\_\_\_" is where you certify the signatures on the petition by writing the date and signing as a circulator of this petition.

The rest of the blanks on the page are not to be filled out by you, and should be left blank to be filled out by the elections officials.

Thank you so much for taking the time to do this, and if you collected more signatures, thank you again as the only way that I can get on the ballot and directly represent you, is with your help. There is no other way I could get all these signatures without volunteers like you.

Now that you finished filling out the petition, the last part to ensure that your signatures will be counted is to get the petition(s) turned into the county office associated with each individual petition no later than July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2010. There are a few ways to do this.

The simplest is to send the petition(s) to me at the following address, and I will deliver them in person, or mail them directly to the county associated with each individual petition. PO Box 20175 Stanford CA 94309

Or, if you have the time, you yourself can send or deliver the petition(s) directly to the county government office associated with each individual petition. You will need to look up in a directory the Elections Office/ Registrar of Voters Office in the county government, or contact me and I can help you as we may already have the information for the county you need. The petition(s) must be delivered to the correct address so I would recommend calling to make sure they know you will be sending this and that it is going to the right location. You may even want to find out the name of the individual who will be counting the signatures and make sure it is sent attention to them, to make sure they get it, or of course you can go in-person. Also I strongly encourage you to also send me a copy of all the signatures so we have a record ourself, of all signatures collected. This is not required but is helpful. If you have any doubts about any of this, or just don't have the time, then simply send it to me at the address above, and I will make sure it is delivered to the right location.
